

History & Heritage on the Harbor

Take a drive to Scituate to take in the sights and history of this coastal town. Enjoy a walk around the Scituate Lighthouse and the jetty. On your way, stop by The Bates House to learn about two brave young girls. Check out Lawson Tower, just a short drive from the Harbor on your way to North Scituate. Although not open for the public, you can still view these historical gems and learn about them at the Scituate Historical Society.

Take a drive down to North Scituate and stop into Board 143 for a charcuterie box. Head back down to the harbor or head over to Roht Marine just across the town line in Marshfield for sunset on the North River (and some fried seafood or a lobster roll).
