Explore the mural-walk on Ripley Road (Large-scale collaborative mural by Boston and Colombian street artists on South Shore Art Center façade, 119 Ripley Road; a series of collaborative murals by South Shore teens on South Shore Art Center west exterior, along train tracks; and More Love is OK mural Frank Marval on Fresh Feast façade, 105 Ripley Road).

Walk down Main Street and check out gift shops, boutiques, and the general store.
